APGA is the major industry partner in the Future Fuels Cooperative Research Centre (FFCRC). The FFCRC is conducting the research that will underpin the safe and efficient use of renewable gases to produce the energy transformation we need to get to net-zero emissions. The work the Future Fuels CRC undertakes is keenly guided by industry advisors from APGA's Research and Standards Committee (RSC) which also provides a rapid path by which today's research is turned into tomorrow's industry practice. The RSC is part of an international tripartite arrangement with pipeline research bodies in the United States and Europe where all three parties share research and avoid costly duplication.

Our partnership with the Future Fuels CRC is part of APGA's focus on ensuring the pipeline and gas industries are great places to work with relevant, meaningful careers for our most important asset: Our people.
